

Historical & Projected Civil Works Obligations




NOTE: ~\$25 billion in 10 Supplemental Appropriations from FY05-13



Sequestration?

- 5 Percent for most accounts
- Annual appropriations are sequestered (\$255M)
- Sandy supplemental funds are sequestered (\$268M)
- Non-Federal cost sharing funds are sequestered (\$14M)
- Specific project impacts will be determined through development of FY13 "work plan."
